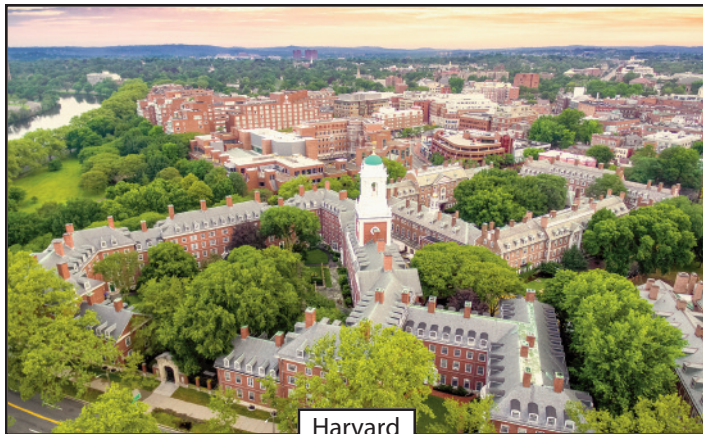

Day 1

This morning, we depart on our journey to Boston with a professional Bianco Tour Director. En route, we will make stops for comfort and lunch on our own. Dinner will be included this evening before checking into our hotel in Lewisburg, PA for the evening.

Day 2

Breakfast is included this morning at the hotel before departing for Boston. Rest stops will be made on route for comfort and convenience. Dinner is included this evening at the **Publick House Historic Inn**. Built in 1771 and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Publick House can be found in the small New England town of Sturbridge. Enjoy the Yankee hospitality and be warmed by the same magnificent open hearths that warmed our early American ancestors. Following dinner we make the last short trip toward Boston and check in at the Hyatt Place Braintree; our home for the next three nights.

Day 3

Following our included breakfast at the hotel, we depart in preparation for our first full day in Boston. Our first stop takes us on an 80 minute tour of Boston on the **Boston Ducks**. The Ducks are WWII style amphibious landing vehicles made to tour on land and then splashdown into the Charles River to continue the tour on water. Our unique tour will return to the Prudential Center where we have some shopping time and an opportunity to get lunch on our own. Later this afternoon, we will visit the **USS Constitution Ship and Museum**. The museum has interactive galleries that will take us on a 200 year voyage back to the US Revolution. A docent will teach us about Life at Sea and we will have time to tour the USS Constitution ship on our own. Dinner will be included this evening at **Cheers!** This historic location on Beacon Hill was the inspiration of the acclaimed TV series.

Day 4

Another breakfast is included this morning at the hotel. We will then make our way to **Harvard**. Harvard is filled with history and we will tour the campus with either a current student or alumni. Our leisurely walking tour will begin in Harvard square and will take us past the Johnston Gate, Memorial Hall and other memorable buildings. Next we head downtown Boston to **Faneuil Hall**, steps away from the waterfront, Faneuil Hall is as alive today as it was in 1742 when our nation's fathers proclaimed it "The Cradle of Liberty." For 280 years, Faneuil Hall has been a prominent meeting location for residents and visitors to Boston and a central point of commerce for the city. For your free time choose to have lunch, shop, enjoy the street performers, or walk through the historic buildings. After some time to refresh, we spend our evening aboard the elegant **Spirit of Boston** for dinner, a harbor cruise and dancing the night away under the stars.

Day 5

Another included breakfast this morning and we have one more morning to enjoy Boston before working our way home. **The New England Aquarium** experience is centered on the facility's Giant Ocean Tank. Measuring up to 40 feet wide, this tank holds a whopping 200,000 gallons of salty water. The rest of the aquarium is built with this massive tank as the focal point. We will have time to explore the aquarium, experience a 3D movie, and have lunch before working our way to upstate New York where we will overnight.

Day 6

Breakfast is included this morning before we continue our journey home. We will make rest stops and a lunch stop on our own en route. Thank you for traveling with Bianco Tours. We will see you on your next adventure.
